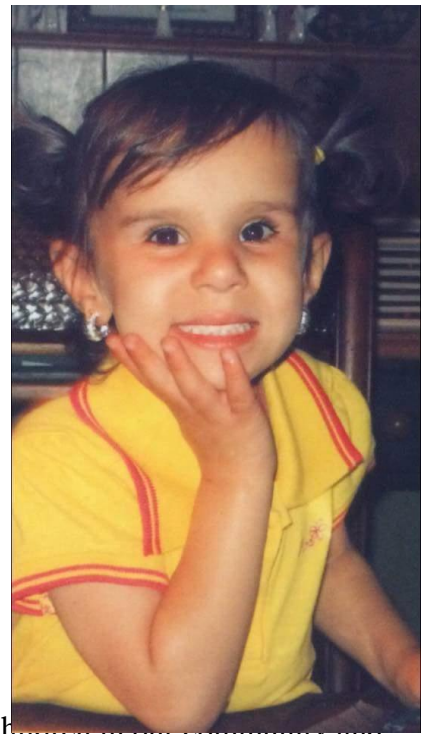
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Mission:

We had another successful year with fulfilling our mission to identify new children in our community and help them obtain the extensive array of services needed to support them. Highlights from the year include:

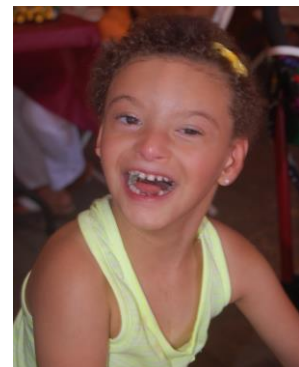
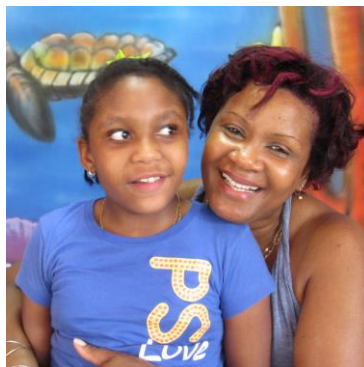
Home Care Programs:

We assisted more than 600 children during 2015. Our Home Care programs are broken down into two main categories:

- **Care-at-Home Case Management Program:** This program assisted 266 children.
- **Family Support Programs:**
Our Family Support programs include:
Non-Medicaid Service Coordination, Respite Services, Crisis Service Coordination, Reimbursement Program, Emergency Respite, Assistive Technology, Advocacy, Training and Counseling. We also assisted 492 families with obtaining information and referrals. These programs assisted 741 children with some families receiving more than one support service.



The Care-at-Home Case Management Program had an increase in the number of children served. We continue to work with a coalition of parents, professionals and attorneys to assure essential services are available for parents to safely care for their children at home.

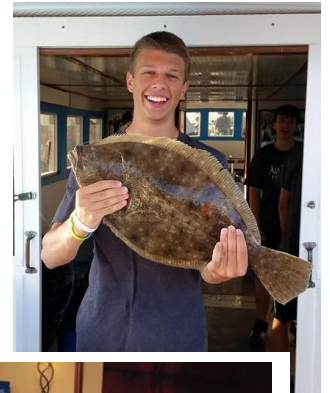


Fundraising:
